Did you know? Vintage coupes (the preferred way to serve champagne prior to the flute's total takeover by the 1980s) are the perfect way to add extra authenticity to your classic cocktails, or make a bubbly toast in old-school style.

The one included here comes from the Celeste pattern, first produced in 1960 by Seneca. Founded in 1891, Seneca's big turn-of-the-century success came from making thin etched tumblers for bars and advertisements, from whiskey to banks. These were the "red Solo cup" of their day and they made several thousands.

Specialty cutting and decorating was an important part of the Seneca business, and they made custom designs for the Ritz Carlton, the Pinnacle Club, Tiffany & Co., Neiman-Marcus, and many others.

Although the company was out of business by 1982, you can almost taste the history when you sip something special in a piece made by such a storied company.
